- 9. Landscaping (residential ONLY NO commercial work)
- 10. Power washing
- 11. Rescreening (NO installation of aluminum, wood or vinyl)
- 12. Trash hauling (NO construction debris)
- 13. Window tinting
- 14. Window treatment installation (i.e. blinds, verticals)
- 15. Assembly of prefabricated items (i.e. shelves, bookcases)
- 16. Replace intake air handler filter (NO duct work or dismantling of the system)

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ

TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY FILING REQUIREMENTS

Unless expressly exempt, Section 196.011, <u>Florida Statutes requires the ad valorem taxation of all property located in this state, both real and personal</u>. The application for a business tax receipt to conduct a business in Charlotte County is an indication that you are, or will be, in possession of tangible personal property that must be placed on Charlotte County's ad valorem tax roll.

Any item owned and used in your business venture is considered tangible personal property, this includes any furnishings, fixtures, and equipment. All property utilized by your business <u>must</u> be reported on the annual tangible personal property tax return.

A tangible personal property tax return will be mailed to you in January. **THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED** and returned to us by **April 1** to be eligible for up to a \$25,000 exemption on tangible personal property. If you feel this form does not apply, contact our office promptly.

If you have a **home-based/mobile** business or **rental** property, you may file the tangible personal property tax return early. Please stop by our Murdock office for further information.
